

## VPK Progress Monitoring Program Pilot Year 2, 2021-2022 Email Update

Update #4: August 19, 2021


Dear VPK Progress Monitoring Pilot Providers,

We hope that all is going well as the new school year begins. As a reminder, the administration of the VPK Assessment is still required per statute 6M-8.620 in AP1 and AP3 for pilot provider participants during the 2021-2022 VPK School Year Program. The Star Early Literacy Assessment will also be administered during the 2021-2022 VPK School Year Program for pilot participants.

To begin the year, you must set the Star Early Literacy screening windows in the Renaissance system for AP1 (first 30 calendar days) and AP3 (last 30 calendar days), AP2 has already been set for you. Instructions on setting screening windows are available in both [PDF](#) and [Video](#) format.

We wanted to let you know to expect an update under the “Course Name” within the Renaissance Pilot site system. Previously under Course Name you would see “VPK Pilot”. With the update you will see the following information, “County Number, Coalition Name, Provider Type.”
