Early learning activities related to providing or contracting for the provision of home instructional services to at-risk children, ages three through five, who are Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)-eligible. HIPPY provides training and technical assistance for parental involvement in the early education of their children, including family and program support, child assessments, developmentally appropriate curricula and lesson planning, teacher/faculty-child interactions, and other activities which increase school readiness and boost long-term school success for children and families.
