- **Before** Test Administration:
 - Obtain the Testing Schedule from your Administrator
 - Demo Star Early Literacy Intro Video and Sample Items: ensure students know how to use technology (mouse, trackpad, touchscreen, scrolling, etc.)
 - Obtain Student usernames and passwords and the Monitor Password
 - Preparing the testing environment and materials (i.e., devices, headphones)
 - Know which students have Testing Accommodation preferences (only for students with an IEP or 504 Plan)
- **During** Test Administration:
 - Actively monitor students (the best “help” is no help when students are stuck)
 - How to manage Test Administration through technical issues (i.e., internet goes out, scrolling/mouse issues, pausing/stopping a test, etc.)
- **After** Test Administration:
 - Where to find and run reports
 - Provide a copy of the Star Parent Report to families within 7 days of Test Administration as required as part of the FAST using Star Early Literacy
 - Basic understanding of scores (scaled score, PR, benchmarks, literacy classifications) and how they inform next instructional steps
